Job 4:3-6 (NLT)

³ “In the past you have encouraged many people; you have strengthened those who were weak. ⁴ Your words have supported those who were falling; you encouraged those with shaky knees. ⁵ But now when trouble strikes, you lose heart. You are terrified when it touches you. ⁶ Doesn’t your reverence for God give you confidence? Doesn’t your life of integrity give you hope?

Job 8:8-10 (CEV)

⁸ Our ancestors were wise, so learn from them. ⁹ Our own time has been short, like a fading shadow, and we know very little. ¹⁰ But they will instruct you with great understanding.

Proverbs 11:14 (NLT)

¹⁴ Without wise leadership, a nation falls; there is safety in having many advisers.

Proverbs 12:15 (ASV)

¹⁵ The way of a fool is right in his own eyes; But he that is wise hearkeneth unto counsel.

Proverbs 15:22 (ASV)

²² Where there is no counsel, purposes are disappointed; But in the multitude of counsellors they are established.

Proverbs 19:20 (AMP)

²⁰ Hear counsel, receive instruction, and accept correction, that you may be wise in the time to come.
