

ANGELS

Genesis 24:40 (KJV)

⁴⁰ And he said unto me, The LORD, before whom I walk will send his angel with thee, and prosper thy way; and thou shalt take a wife for my son of my kindred, and of my father's house:

Acts 12:11,15 (NLT)

¹¹ Peter finally came to his senses. "It's really true!" he said. "The Lord has sent his angel and save me from Herod and from what the Jewish leaders had planned to do to me!". ¹⁵ "You're out of your mind!" they said. When she insisted, they decided, "It must be his angel."

Exodus 23:20-23 (KJV)

²⁰ Behold, I send an Angel before thee, to keep thee in the way, and to bring thee into the place which I have prepared.. ²¹ Beware of him, and obey his voice, provoke him not; for he will not pardon your transgressions: for my name is in him. ²² But if thou shalt indeed obey his voice, and do all that I speak; then I will be an enemy unto thine enemies, and an adversary unto thine adversaries. ²³ For mine Angel shall go before thee, and bring thee in unto the Amorites, and the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Canaanites, the Hivites, and the Jebusites: and I will cut them off.

Numbers 22:23-28 (AMP)

²³ And the donkey saw the Angel of the Lord standing in the way and His sword drawn in His hand, and the donkey turned aside out of the way and went into the field. And Balaam struck the donkey to turn her into the way. ²⁴ But the Angel of the Lord stood in a path of the vineyards, a wall on this side and a wall on that side. ²⁵ And when the donkey saw the Angel of the Lord, she thrust herself against the wall and crushed Balaam's foot against it, and he struck her again. ²⁶ And the Angel of the Lord went further and stood in a narrow place where there was no room to turn, either to the right hand or to the left. ²⁷ And when the donkey saw the Angel of the Lord, she fell down under Balaam, and Balaam's anger was kindled and he struck the donkey with his staff. ²⁸ And the Lord opened the mouth of the donkey, and she said to Balaam, What have I done to you that you should strike me these three times?

Job 1:6 (KJV)

⁶ Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them.

Psalms 34:7 (CEV)

⁷ If you honor the LORD, his angel will protect you.

Psalms 91:9-12 (NLT)

⁹ If you make the LORD your refuge, if you make the Most High your shelter, ¹⁰ no evil will conquer you; no plague will come near your home. ¹¹ For he will order his angels to protect you wherever you go. ¹² They will hold you up with their hands so you won't even hurt your foot on a stone.

Daniel 6:22 (KJV)

²² MY God hath sent his angel, and hath shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: forasmuch as before him innocency was found in me; and also before thee, O king, have I done no hurt.

Matthew 4:11 (KJV)

¹¹ Then the devil leaveth him, and, behold, angels came and ministered unto him.

Matthew 13:41-42 (KJV)

⁴¹ The Son of man shall send forth his angels, and they shall gather out of his kingdom all things that offend, and them which do iniquity; ⁴² And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be wailing and gnashing of teeth.

Matthew 18:10 (NLT)

¹⁰ "Beware that you don't look down on any of these little ones. For I tell you that in heaven their angels are always in the presence of my heavenly Father.

Luke 1:11-13 (KJV)

¹¹ And there appeared unto him an angel of the Lord standing on the right side of the altar of incense. ¹² And when Zacharias saw him, he was troubled, and fear fell upon him. ¹³ But the angel said unto him, Fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John.

Luke 15:10 (NLT)

¹⁰ In the same way, there is joy in the presence of God's angels when even one sinner repents."

2 Corinthians 11:14-15 (CEV)

¹⁴ And it is no wonder. Even Satan tries to make himself look like an angel of light. ¹⁵ So why does it seem strange for Satan's servants to pretend to do what is right? Someday they will get exactly what they deserve.

Revelation 20:1-3 (KJV)

¹ And I saw an angel come down from heaven, having the key of the bottomless pit and a great chain in his hand. ² And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and Satan, and bound him a thousand years, ³ And cast him into the bottomless pit, and shut him up, and set a seal upon him, that he should deceive the nations no more, till the thousand years should be fulfilled: and after that he must be loosed a little season.

Hebrews 13:2 (ASV)

² Forget not to show love unto strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares.

Hebrews 1:4-14 (AMP)

⁴ [Taking a place and rank by which] He Himself became as much superior to angels as the glorious Name (title) which He has inherited is different from and more excellent than theirs. ⁵ For to which of the angels did [God] ever say, You are My Son, today I have begotten You [established You in an official Sonship relation, with kingly dignity]? And again, I will be to Him a Father, and He will be to Me a Son? ⁶ Moreover, when He brings the firstborn Son again into the habitable world, He says, Let all the angels of God worship Him. ⁷ Referring to the angels He says, [God] Who makes His angels winds and His ministering servants flames of fire; ⁸ But as to the Son, He says to Him, Your throne, O God, is forever and ever (to the ages of the ages), and the scepter of Your kingdom is a scepter of absolute righteousness (of justice and straightforwardness). ⁹ You have loved righteousness [You have delighted in integrity, virtue, and uprightness in purpose, thought, and action] and You have hated lawlessness (injustice and iniquity). Therefore God, [even] Your God (Godhead), has anointed You with the oil of exultant joy and gladness above and beyond Your companions. ¹⁰ And [further], You, Lord, did lay the foundation of the earth in the beginning, and the heavens are the works of Your hands. ¹¹ They will perish, but You remain and continue permanently; they will all grow old and wear out like a garment. ¹² Like a mantle [thrown about one's self] You will roll them up, and they will be changed and replaced by others. But You remain the same, and Your years will never end nor come to failure. ¹³ Besides, to which of the angels has He ever said, Sit at My right hand [associated with Me in My royal dignity] till I make your enemies a stool for your feet? ¹⁴ Are not the angels all ministering spirits (servants) sent out in the service [of God for the assistance] of those who are to inherit salvation?

Revelation 3:5 (KJV)

⁵ He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

Revelation 18:1 (KJV)

¹ And after these things I saw another angel come down from heaven, having great power; and the earth was lightened with his glory.

Revelation 19:10 (CEV)

¹⁰ I knelt at the feet of the angel and began to worship him. But the angel said, "Don't do that! I am a servant, just like you and everyone else who tells about Jesus. Don't worship anyone but God. Everyone who tells about Jesus does it by the power of the Spirit."
