Genesis 27:44 (NLT)

⁴⁴ Stay there with him until your brother cools off.

Numbers 11:1 (CEV)

¹ One day the Israelites started complaining about their troubles. The LORD heard them and became so angry that he destroyed the outer edges of their camp with fire.

Judges 2:14 (NLT)

¹⁴ This made the LORD burn with anger against Israel, so he handed them over to raiders who stole their possessions. He turned them over to their enemies all around, and they were no longer able to resist them.

2 Samuel 24:1 (KJV)

² And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go number Israel and Judah.

2 Kings 22:13 (NLT)

¹³ "Go to the Temple and speak to the LORD for me and for the people and for all Judah. Inquire about the words written in this scroll that has been found. For the LORD's great anger is burning against us because our ancestors have not obeyed the words in this scroll. WE have not been doing everything it says we must do."

Psalms 2:12 (AMP)

¹² Kiss the Son [pay homage to Him in purity], lest He be angry and you perish in the way, for soon shall His wrath be kindled. O Blessed (happy, fortunate, and to be envied) are all those who seek refuge and put their trust in Him!

Psalms 7:11 (NLT)

¹¹ God is an honest judge. He is angry with the wicked every day.

John 3:36 (KJV)

³⁶ He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life: and he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him.

Romans 2:8 (CEV)

⁸ But he will show how angry and furious he can be with every selfish person who rejects the truth and wants to do evil.

Proverbs 22:24-25 (ASV)

²⁴ Make no friendship with a man that is given to anger; And with a wrathful man thou shalt not go:
²⁵ Lest thou learn this ways, And get a snare to thy soul.

Job 15:12 (AMP)

¹² Why does your heart carry you away [why allow yourself to be controlled by feeling]? And why do your eyes flash [in anger or contempt],

Ecclesiastes 7:9 (NLT)

⁹ Control your temper, for anger labels you a fool.

Proverbs 15:1 (NLT)

¹ A gentle answer deflects anger, but harsh words make tempers flare.

Proverbs 29:11 (KJV)

¹¹ A fool uttereth all his mind: but a wise man keepeth it in till afterwards.

Colossians 3:8 (AMP)

⁸ But now put away and rid yourselves [completely] of all these things: anger, rage, bad feeling toward others, curses and slander, and foulmouthed abuse and shameful utterances from your lips!

Matthew 5:21-22 (CEV)

²¹ You know that our ancestors were told, "Do not murder" and "A murderer must be brought to trial." ²² But I promise you that if you are angry with someone, you will have to stand trial. If you call someone a fool, you will be taken to court. And if you say that someone is worthless, you will be in danger of the fires of hell.
