## **Deuteronomy 8:3 (NKJV)**

<sup>3</sup> So He humbled you, allowed you to hunger, and fed you with manna which you did not know nor did your fathers know, that He might make you know that man shall not live by bread alone: but man lives by every word that proceeds from the mouth of the LORD.

## **Job 23:12 (JNV)**

<sup>12</sup> Neither have I gone back from the commandment of his lips; I have esteemed the words of his mouth more than my necessary food.

## **Matthew 4:4 (NIV)**

## **Psalms 119:105 (KJV)**

<sup>17</sup> And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

### **2 Timothy 3:16 (NIV)**

### **Hebrews 4:12 (NKJV)**

### **James 1:23-25 (NKJV)**
