

## DEATH

### **Genesis 3:19 (KJV)**

<sup>19</sup> In the sweat of thy face shalt thou eat bread, till thou return unto the ground; for out of it wast thou taken; for dust thou art, and unto dust shalt thou return.

### **1 Kings 19:4 (KJV)**

<sup>4</sup> But he himself went a day's journey into the wilderness, and came and sat down under a juniper tree: and he requested for himself that he might die; and said, It is enough; now, O LORD, take away my life; for I am not better than my fathers.

### **2 Samuel 12:15-23 (NKJV)**

<sup>15</sup> And the LORD struck the child that Uriah's wife bore to David, and it became ill. <sup>16</sup> David therefore pleaded with God for the child, and David fasted and went in and lay all night on the ground. <sup>17</sup> So the elders of his house arose and went to him, to raise him up from the ground. But he would not, nor did he eat food with them. <sup>18</sup> Then on the seventh day it came to pass that the child died. And the servants of David were afraid to tell him that the child was dead. For they said, "Indeed, while the child was alive, we spoke to him, and he would not heed our voice. How can we tell him that the child is dead? He may do some harm!" <sup>19</sup> When David saw that his servants were whispering, David perceived that the child was dead. Therefore David, said to his servants, "Is the child dead?" And they said, "He is dead." <sup>20</sup> So David arose from the ground, washed and anointed himself, and changed his clothes; and he went into the house of the LORD and worshiped. Then he went to his own house; and when he requested, they set food before him, and he ate. <sup>21</sup> Then his servants said to him, "What is this that you have done? You fasted and wept for the child while he was alive, but when the child died, you arose and ate food." <sup>22</sup> And he said, "While the child was alive, I fasted and wept; for I said, 'Who can tell whether the LORD will be gracious to me, that the child may live?' <sup>23</sup> But now he is dead; why should I fast? Can I bring him back again? I shall go to him, but he shall not return to me."

### **2 Kings 20:1 (KJV)**

<sup>1</sup> In those days was Hezekiah sick unto death. And the prophet Isaiah the son of Amoz came to him, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Set thine house in order; for thou shalt die, and not live .

### **Job 16:22 (NIV)**

<sup>22</sup> "Only a few years will pass before I go on the journey of no return.

### **Job 17:1 (NKJV)**

<sup>1</sup> "My spirit is broken, my days are extinguished, the grave is ready for me.

### **Job 21:23-25 (NIV)**

<sup>23</sup> One man dies in full vigor, completely secure and at ease, <sup>24</sup> his body well nourished, his bones rich with marrow. <sup>25</sup> Another man dies in bitterness of soul, never having enjoyed anything good.

### **Psalms 49:19 (NIV)**

<sup>19</sup> he will join the generation of his fathers, who will never see the light of life.

### **Psalms 55:4 (KJV)**

<sup>4</sup> My heart is sore pained within me: and the terrors of death are fallen upon me.

### **Psalms 89:47-48 (NKJV)**

<sup>47</sup> Remember how short my time is; for what futility have You created all the children of men? <sup>48</sup> What man can live and not see death? Can he deliver his life from the power of the grave?

### **Psalms 146:3-4 (AMP)**

<sup>3</sup> Put not your trust in princes, in a son of man, in whom there is no help. <sup>4</sup> When his breath leaves him, he returns to his earth; in that very day his [previous] thoughts, plans, and purposes perish.

### **Ecclesiastes 2:16 (KJV)**

<sup>16</sup> For there is no remembrance of the wise more than of the fool for ever; seeing that which now is in the days to come shall all be forgotten. And how dieth the wise man? as the fool.

### **Ecclesiastes 5:15 (KJV)**

<sup>15</sup> As he came forth of his mother's womb, naked shall he return to go as he came, and shall take nothing of his labour, which he may carry away in his hand.

### **Ecclesiastes 7:17 (NKJV)**

<sup>17</sup> Do not be overly wicked, nor be foolish: Why should you die before your time?

### **Ecclesiastes 8:8 (CEV)**

<sup>8</sup> We cannot control the wind or determine the day of our death. There is no escape in time of war, and no one can hide behind evil.

### **Ecclesiastes 9:5 (KJV)**

<sup>5</sup> For the living know that they shall die: but the dead know not any thing, neither have they any more a reward; for the memory of them is forgotten.

### **Matthew 8:21-22 (NKJV)**

<sup>21</sup> Then another of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, let me first go and bury my father." <sup>22</sup> But Jesus said to him, "Follow Me, and let the dead bury their own dead."

### **Matthew 22:23-30 (KJV)**

<sup>23</sup> The same day came to him the Sadducees, which say that there is no resurrection, and asked him, <sup>24</sup> Saying, Master, Moses said, If a man die, having no children, his brother shall marry his wife, and raise up seed unto his brother. <sup>25</sup> Now there were with us seven brethren: and the first, when he had married a wife, deceased, and, having no issue, left his wife unto his brother: <sup>26</sup> Likewise the second also, and the third, unto the seventh. <sup>27</sup> And last of all the women died also. <sup>28</sup> Therefore in the resurrection whose wife shall she be of the seven? for they all had her. <sup>29</sup> Jesus answered and said unto them, Ye do err, not knowing the scriptures, nor the power of God. <sup>30</sup> For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven.

### **Mark 5:38-42 (NIV)**

<sup>38</sup> When they came to the home of the synagogue ruler, Jesus saw a commotion, with people crying and wailing loudly. <sup>39</sup> He went in and said to them, "Why all this commotion and wailing? The child is not dead but asleep." <sup>40</sup> But they laughed at him. After he put them all out, he took the child's father and mother and the disciples who were with him, and went in where the child was. <sup>41</sup> He took her by the hand and said to her, "Talitha koum!" (which means, "Little girl, I say to you, get up!") <sup>42</sup> Immediately the girl stood up and walked around (she was twelve years old). At this they were completely astonished.

### **Mark 15:37-39 (NKJV)**

<sup>37</sup> And Jesus cried out with a loud voice, and breathed His last. <sup>38</sup> Then the veil of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. <sup>39</sup> So when the centurion, who stood opposite Him, saw that He cried out like this and breathed His last, he said, "Truly this Man was the Son of God!"

### **Luke 20:38 (CEV)**

<sup>38</sup> So the Lord isn't the God of the dead, but of the living. This means that everyone is alive as far as God is concerned.

### **John 5:28-29 (KJV)**

<sup>28</sup> Marvel not at this: for the hour is coming, in the which all that are in the graves shall hear his voice, <sup>29</sup> And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

### **John 8:51 (AMP)**

<sup>51</sup> I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, if anyone observes My teaching [lives in accordance with My message, keeps My word], he will by no means ever see and experience death.

### **John 16:5-7 (CEV)**

<sup>5</sup> But now I am going back to the Father who sent me, and none of you asks me where I am going. <sup>6</sup> You are very sad from hearing all of this. <sup>7</sup> But I tell you that I am going to do what is best for you. That is why I am going away. The Holy Spirit cannot come to help you until I leave. But after I am gone, I will send the Spirit to you.

### **John 17:4 (KJV)**

<sup>4</sup> I have glorified thee on the earth; I have finished the work which thou gavest me to do.

### **Acts 2:29-35 (CEV)**

<sup>29</sup> My friends, it is right for me to speak to you about our ancestor David. He died and was buried, and his tomb is still here. <sup>30</sup> But David was a prophet, and he knew that God had made a promise he would not break. He had told David that someone from his own family would someday be king. <sup>31</sup> David knew this would happen, and so he told us that Christ would be raised to life. He said that God would not leave him in the grave or let his body decay. <sup>32</sup> All of us can tell you that God has raised Jesus to life! <sup>33</sup> Jesus was taken up to sit at the right side of God, and he was given the Holy Spirit, just as the Father had promised. Jesus is also the one who has given the Spirit to us, and that is what you are now seeing and hearing. <sup>34</sup> David didn't go up to heaven. So he wasn't talking about himself when he said, "The Lord told my Lord to sit at this right side," <sup>35</sup> until he made my Lord's enemies into a footstool for him."

### **1 Corinthians 15:26 (KJV)**

<sup>26</sup> The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.

### **2 Corinthians 5:1 (NIV)**

<sup>1</sup> Now we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed, we have a building from God, an eternal house in heaven, not built by human hands.

### **2 Timothy 4:6-8 (AMP)**

<sup>6</sup> For I am already about to be sacrificed [my life is about to be poured out as a drink offering]; the time of my [spirit's] release [from the body] is at hand and I will soon go free. <sup>7</sup> I have fought the good (worthy, honorable, and noble) fight, I have finished the race, I have kept (firmly held) the faith. <sup>8</sup> [As to what remains] henceforth there is laid up for me the [victor's] crown of righteousness [for being right with God and doing right], which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me and recompense me on that [great] day – and not to me only, but also to all those who have loved and yearned for and welcomed His appearing (His return).

### **1 Thessalonians 5:10 (CEV)**

<sup>10</sup> Christ died for us, so that we could live with him, whether we are alive or dead when he comes.

### **1 Peter 1:24-25 (KJV)**

<sup>24</sup> For all flesh is as grass, and all the glory of man as the flower of grass. The grass withereth, and the flower thereof falleth away: <sup>25</sup> But the word of the Lord endureth for ever. And this is the word which by the gospel is preached unto you.
