Exodus 15:1-2 (KJV)

¹ Then sang Moses and the children of Israel this song unto the LORD, and spake, saying, I will sing unto the LORD, for he hath triumphed gloriously: the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea. ² The LORD is my strength and song, and he is become my salvation: he is my God, and I will prepare him an habitation; my father's God, and I will exalt him.

Nehemiah 9:5 (KJV)

⁵¹ Then the Levites, Jeshua, and Kadmiel, Bani, Hshabniah, Sherebiah, Hodijah, Shebaniah, and Pethahiah, said, Stand up and bless the LORD your God for ever and ever: and blessed be thy glorious name, which is exalted above all blessing and praise.

Psalms 43:4 (KJV)

⁴ Then will I go unto the altar of God, unto God my exceeding joy: yea, upon the harp will I praise thee, O God my God.

Psalms 47:7 (KJV)

⁷ For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding.

Psalms 56:10 (KJV)

¹⁰ In God will I praise his word: in the LORD will I praise his word.

Psalms 57:7 (KJV)

⁷ My heart is fixed, O God, my heart is fixed: I will sing and give praise.

Proverbs 65:1 (NIV)

¹ Praise awaits you, O God, in Zion; to you our vows will be fulfilled.

Psalms 70:4 (NKJV)

⁴ Let all those who seek You rejoice and be glad in You; And let those who love Your salvation say continually, "Let God be magnified!"

Psalms 96:8 (KJV)

⁸ Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts.

Psalm 103:1-22 (AMP)

¹ Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul; and all that is [deepest] within me, bless His holy name! ² Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul, and forget not [one of] all His benefits - ³ Who forgives [every one of] all you iniquities, Who heals [each one of] all your diseases, ⁴ Who redeems your life from the pit and corruption, Who beautifies, dignifies, and crowns you with loving-kindness and tender mercy; ⁵ Who satisfies your mouth [your necessity and desire at your personal age and situation] with good so that your youth, renewed, is like the eagle's [strong, overcoming, soaring]! ⁶ The Lord executes righteousness and justice [not for me only, but] for all who are oppressed. ⁷ He made known His way [of righteousness and justice] to Moses, His acts to the children of Israel. ⁸ The Lord is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and plenteous in mercy and loving-kindness. ⁹ He will not always chide or be contending, neither will He keep His anger forever or hold a grudge. ¹⁰ He has not dealt with us after our sins nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. ¹¹ For as the heavens are high above the earth, so great are His mercy and loving-kindness toward those who reverently and worshipfully fear Him. ¹² As far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed our transgressions from us. ¹³ As a father loves and pities his children, so the Lord loves and pities those who fear Him [with reverence, worship, and awe]. ¹⁴ For He know our frame, He [earnestly] remembers and imprints [on His heart] that we are dust. ¹⁵ As for man, his days are as grass; as a flower of the field, so he flourishes. ¹⁶ For the wind passes over it and it is gone, and its place shall know it no more. ¹⁷ But the mercy and loving-kindness of the Lord are from everlasting to everlasting upon those who reverently and worshipfully fear Him, and His righteousness is to children's children - ¹⁸ To such as keep His covenant [hearing, receiving, loving, and obeying it] and to those who [earnestly] remember His commandments to do them [imprinting them on their hearts]. ¹⁹ The Lord has established His throne in the heavens, and His kingdom rules over all. ²⁰ Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, you His angels, you mighty ones who do His commandments, hearkening to the voice of His word. ²¹ Bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, all you His hosts, you His ministers who do His pleasure. ²² Bless the Lord, all His works in all places of His dominion; bless (affectionately, gratefully praise) the Lord, O my soul !

Psalm 115:1 (NKJV)

¹ Not unto us, O LORD, not unto us, But to Your name give glory, Because of Your mercy, Because of Your truth.

Acts 12:21-23 (NIV)

²¹ On the appointed day Herod, wearing his royal robes, sat on his throne and delivered a public address to the people. ²² They shouted, "This is the voice of a god, not of a man." ²³ Immediately, because Herod did not give praise to God, an angel of the Lord struck him down, and he was eaten by worms and died.

1 Corinthians 3:7 (NIV)

⁷ So neither he who plants nor he who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow.

Proverbs 27:2 (KJV)

² Let another man praise thee, and not thine own mouth; a stranger, and not thine own lips.

Proverbs 27:21 (NKJV)

²¹ The refining pot is for silver and the furnace for gold, and a man is valued by what others say of him.

Jeremiah 33:11 (AMP)

¹¹ [There shall be heard again] the voice of joy and the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voices of those who sing as they bring sacrifices of thanksgiving into the house of the Lord, Give praise and thanks to the Lord of hosts, for the Lord is good; for His mercy and kindness and steadfast love endure forever! For I will cause the captivity of the land to be reversed and return to be as it was at first, says the Lord.

Daniel 2:19-23 (KJV)

¹⁹ Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven. ²⁰ Daniel answered and said, Blessed be the name of God for ever and ever: for wisdom and might are his: ²¹ And he changeth the times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom unto the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding: ²² He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what is in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him. ²³ I thank thee, and praise thee, O thou God of my fathers, who hast given me wisdom and might, and hast made known unto me now what we desired of thee: for thou hast now made known unto us the king's matter.

Amos 5:22 (NKJV)

²² Though you offer Me burnt offerings and your grain offerings, I will not accept them, nor will I regard your fattened peace offerings.

Amos 8:3 (CEV)

³ Instead of singing in the temple, they will cry and weep. Dead bodies will be everywhere. So keep silent! I, the LORD, have spoken!"

Amos 8:10 (CEV)

¹⁰ Your festivals and joyful singing will turn into sorrow. You will wear sackcloth and shave your heads, as you would at the death of your only son. It will be a horrible day.

Matthew 11:11-14 (AMP)

¹¹ Truly I tell you, among those born of women there has not risen anyone greater than John the Baptist; yet he who is least in the kingdom of heaven is greater than he. ¹² And from the days of John the Baptist until the present time, the kingdom of heaven has endure violent assault, and violent men seize it by force [as a precious prize—a share in the heavenly kingdom is sought with most ardent zeal and intense exertion]. ¹² For all the Prophets and the Law prophesied up until John. ¹⁴ And if you are willing to receive and accept it, John himself is Elijah who was t come [before the kingdom].

Matthew 21:6-11 (KJV)

¹¹ And the disciples went, and did as Jesus commanded them, ⁷ And brought the ass, and the colt, and put on them their clothes, and they set him thereon. ⁸ And a very great multitude spread their garments in the way; others cut down branches from the trees, and strawed them in the way. ⁹ And the multitudes that went before, and that followed, cried, saying, Hosanna to the son of David: Blessed is he that cometh in the name of the Lord; Hosanna in the highest. ¹⁰ And when he was come into Jerusalem, all the city was moved, saying, Who is this? ¹¹ And the multitude said, This is Jesus the prophet of Nazareth of Galilee.

Matthew 21:15-16 (KJV)

¹⁵ And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, sand saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased. ¹⁶ And said unto him, Hearest thou what these say? And Jesus saith unto them, Yea; have ye never read, Out of the mouth of babes and sucklings thou hast perfected praise?

1 Corinthians 4:5 (CEV)

⁵ So don't judge anyone until the Lord returns. He will show what is hidden in the dark and what is in everyone's heart. Then God will be the one who praises each of us.

2 Corinthians 10:17-18 (CEV)

¹⁷ The Scriptures day, "If you want to brag, then brag about the Lord." ¹⁸ You may brag about yourself, but the only approval that counts is the Lord's approval.

Galatians 1:10 (NIV)

¹⁰ Am I now trying to win the approval of men, or of God? Or am I trying to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a servant of Christ.

1 Thessalonians 2:1-6 (NIV)

¹ You know, brothers, that our visit to you was not a failure. ² We had previously suffered and been insulted in Philippi, as you know, but with the help of our God we dared to tell you his gospel in spite of strong opposition. ³ For the appeal we make does not spring from error or impure motives, nor are we trying to trick you. ⁴ On the contrary, we speak as men approved by God to be entrusted with the gospel. We are not trying to please men but God, who tests our hearts. ⁵ You know we never used flattery, nor did we put on a mask to cover up greed – God is our witness. ⁶ We were not looking for praise from men, not from you or anyone else.

1 Thessalonians 3:8-10 (CEV)

⁸ Your strong faith in the Lord is like a breath of new life. ⁹ How can we possibly thank God enough for all the happiness you have brought us? ¹⁰ Day and night we sincerely pray that we will see you again and help you to have an even stronger faith.

Revelation 5:13-14 (KJV)

¹³ And every creature which is in heave, and on the earth, and under the earth, and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, heard I saying, Blessing, and honour, and glory, and power, be unto him that sitteth upon the throne, and unto the Lamb for ever and ever. ¹⁴ And the four beasts said, Amen. And the four and twenty elders fell down and worshipped him that liveth for ever and ever.

Revelation 7:11-12 (KJV)

¹¹ And all the angels stood round about the throne, and about the elders and the four beasts, and fell before the throne on their faces and worshipped God. ¹² Saying, Amen: Blessing, and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honour, and power, and might, be unto our God for ever and ever. Amen.

Revelation 15:3-4 (NKJV)

³ They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: “ Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints! ⁴ Who shall not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, for Your judgments have been manifested.”
