

## PROSPERITY

### Genesis 39:2 (KJV)

<sup>2</sup> And the LORD was with Joseph, and he was a prosperous man; and he was in the house of his master the Egyptian.

### Deuteronomy 8:7-20 (KJV)

<sup>7</sup> For the LORD thy God bringeth thee into a good land, a land of brooks of water, of fountains and depths that spring out of valleys and hills; <sup>8</sup> A land of wheat and barley, and vines, and fig trees, and pomegranates; a land of oil olive, and hone; <sup>9</sup> A land wherein thou shalt eat bread without scarceness, thou shalt not lack any thing in it; a land whose stones are iron, and out of whose hills thou mayest dig brass. <sup>10</sup> When thou hast eaten and are full, then thou shalt bless the LORD thy God for the good land which he that given thee. <sup>11</sup> Beware that thou forget not the LORD thy God, in not keeping his commandments, and his judgments, and his statutes, which I command thee this day: <sup>12</sup> Lest when thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt therein; <sup>13</sup> And when thy herds and thy flocks multiply, and thy silver and thy gold is multiplied, and all that thou hast is multiplied; <sup>14</sup> Then thine heart be lifted up, and thou forget the LORD thy God, which brought thee forth out of the lad of Egypt, from the house of bondage; <sup>15</sup> Who led thee through that great and terrible wilderness, wherein were fiery serpents, and scorpions, and drought, where there was no water; who brought thee forth water out of the rock of flint; <sup>16</sup> Who fed thee in the wilderness with manna, which thy fathers knew not, that he might humble thee, and that he might prove thee, to do thee good at thy latter end; <sup>17</sup> But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he sware unto thy fathers, as it is this day. <sup>19</sup> And it shall be, if thou do at all forget the LORD thy God, and walk after other gods, and serve them, and worship them, I testify against you this day that ye shall surely perish. <sup>20</sup> As the nations which the LORD destroyeth before your face, so shall ye perish; because ye would not be obedient unto the voice of the LORD your God.

### Deuteronomy 30:1-3 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> "Now it shall come to pass, when all these things come upon you, the blessing and the curse which I have set before you, and you call them to mind among all the nations where the LORD your God drives you, <sup>2</sup> and you return to the LORD your God and obey His voice, according to all that I command you today, you and your children, with all your heart and with all your soul. <sup>3</sup> that the LORD your God will bring you back from captivity, and have compassion on you, and gather you again from all the nations where the LORD your God has scattered you.

### Job 36:11 (KJV)

<sup>11</sup> If they obey and serve him, they shall spend their days in prosperity, and their years in pleasures.

### **Job 42:12 (NKJV)**

<sup>12</sup> Now the LORD blessed the latter days of Job more than his beginning; for he had fourteen thousand sheep, six thousand camels, one thousand yoke of oxen, and one thousand female donkeys.

### **Proverbs 22:16 (NKJV)**

<sup>16</sup> He who oppresses the poor to increase his riches, and he who gives to the rich, will surely come to poverty.

### **Isaiah 2:7-8 (KJV)**

<sup>7</sup> Their land also is full of silver and gold, neither is there any end of their treasures; their land is also full of horses, neither is there any end of their chariots: <sup>8</sup> Their land also is full of idols; they worship the work of their own hands, that which their own finders have made:

### **Jeremiah 11:5 (NIV)**

<sup>5</sup> Then I will fulfill the oath I swore to your forefathers, to give them a land flowing with milk and honey' - the land you possess today.' I answered, 'Amen, LORD.'

### **Jeremiah 12:1-3 (NIV)**

<sup>1</sup> You are always righteous, O LORD, when I bring a case before you. Yet I would speak with you about your justice: Why does the way of the wicked prosper? Why do all the faithless live at ease? <sup>2</sup> You have planted them, and they have taken root; they grow and bear fruit. You are always on their lips but far from their hearts. <sup>3</sup> Yet you know me, O LORD; you see me and test my thoughts about you. Drag them off like sheep to be butchered! Set them apart for the day of slaughter!

### **Ezekiel 16:13-14 (NKJV)**

<sup>13</sup> Thus you were adorned with gold and silver, and your clothing was of fine linen, silk, and embroidered cloth. You ate pastry of fine flour, honey, and oil. You were exceedingly beautiful, and succeeded to royalty. <sup>14</sup> Your fame went out among the nations because of your beauty, for it was perfect through My splendor which I had bestowed on you," says the Lord GOD.

### **Ezekiel 36:11 (KJV)**

<sup>11</sup> And I will multiply upon you man and beast; and they shall increase and bring fruit: and I will settle you after your old estates, and will do better unto you than at your beginnings: and ye shall know that I am the LORD.

### **Daniel 4:27 (NIV)**

<sup>27</sup> Therefore, O king, be pleased to accept my advice: Renounce your sins by doing what is right, and your wickedness by being kind to the oppressed. It may be that then your prosperity will continue."

### **Hosea 13:15 (CEV)**

<sup>15</sup> No matter how much you prosper more than the other tribes, I, the LORD, will wipe you out, just as a scorching desert wind dries up streams of water. I will take away your precious treasures.

### **Joel 3:1 (AMP)**

<sup>1</sup> For behold, in those days and at that time when I shall reverse the captivity and restore the fortunes of Judah and Jerusalem,

### **2 Peter 1:2 (AMP)**

<sup>2</sup> May grace (God's favor) and peace (which is perfect well-being, all necessary good, all spiritual prosperity, and freedom from fears and agitating passions and moral conflicts) be multiplied to you in [the full, personal, precise, and correct] knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.

### **3 John 2-4 (NKJV)**

<sup>2</sup> Beloved, I pray that you may prosper in all things and be in health, just as your soul prospers. <sup>3</sup> For I rejoiced greatly when brethren came and testified of the truth that is in you, just as you walk in the truth. <sup>4</sup> I have no greater joy than to hear that my children walk in truth.

### **1 Corinthians 16:2 (NKJV)**

<sup>2</sup> On the first day of the week let each one of you lay something aside, storing up as he may prosper, that there be no collections when I come.
