## Numbers 16:3-7 (NIV)

<sup>3</sup> They came as a group to oppose Moses and Aaron and said to them, “You have gone too far! The whole community is holy, every one of them, and the LORD is with them. Why then do you set yourselves above the LORD’s assembly?” <sup>4</sup> When Moses heard this, he fell facedown. <sup>5</sup> Then he said to Korah and all his followers: “In the morning the LORD will show who belongs to him and who is holy, and he will have that person come near him. The man he chooses he will cause to come near him. <sup>6</sup> You, Korah, and all your followers are to do this: Take censers <sup>7</sup> and tomorrow put fire and incense in them before the LORD. The name the LORD chooses will be the one who is holy. You Levites have gone too far!”

## Isaiah 26:9 (NIV)

<sup>9</sup> My soul yearns for you in the night; in the morning my spirit longs for you. When your judgments come upon the earth, the people of the world learn righteousness.

## John 8:23 (NKJV)

<sup>23</sup> And He said to them, “You are from beneath; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world.

## 1 Corinthians 1:4-9 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus, <sup>5</sup> that you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge, <sup>6</sup> even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you, <sup>7</sup> so that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ, <sup>8</sup> who will also confirm you to the end, that you may be blameless in the day of our Lord Jesus Christ. <sup>9</sup> God is faithful, by who you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.

## 1 Corinthians 8:4 (KJV)

<sup>4</sup> As concerning therefore the eating of those things that are offered in sacrifice unto idols, we know that an idol is nothing in the world, and that there is none other God but one.

## Matthew 23:23 (NKJV)

<sup>23</sup> “Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithe of mint and anise and cumin, and have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone.

## Luke 17:20-21 (AMP)

<sup>20</sup> Asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He replied to them by saying, The kingdom of God does not come with signs to be observed or with visible display, <sup>21</sup> nor will people say, Look! Here [it is]! Or, See, [it is] there! For behold, the kingdom of God is within you [in your hearts] and among you [surrounding you].

### 3 John 2 (KJV)

<sup>2</sup> Beloved, I wish above all things that thou mayest prosper and be in health, even as thy soul prospereth.

### Revelation 3:15-18 (CEV)

<sup>15</sup> I know everything you have done, and you are not cold or hot. I wish you were either one or the other. <sup>16</sup> But since you are lukewarm and neither cold nor hot, I will spit you out of My mouth. <sup>17</sup> You claim to be rich and successful and to have everything you need. But you don't know how bad off you are. You are pitiful, poor, blind, and naked. <sup>18</sup> Buy your gold from Me. It has been refined in a fire, and it will make you rich. Buy white clothes from Me. Wear them and you can cover up your shameful nakedness. Buy medicine for you eye, so that you will be able to see.
