

## WEALTH

### **Genesis 2:11-12 (CEV)**

<sup>11</sup> The first one is the Pishon River that flows through the land of Havilah, <sup>12</sup> where pure gold, rare perfumes, and precious stones are found.

### **Deuteronomy 6:10-12 (NKJV)**

<sup>10</sup> “So it shall be, when the LORD your God brings you into the land of which He swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give you large and beautiful cities which you did not build, <sup>11</sup> houses full of all good things, which you did not fill, hewn-out wells which you did not dig, vineyards and olive trees which you did not plant – when you have eaten and are full – <sup>12</sup> then beware, lest you forget the LORD who brought you out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage.

### **Deuteronomy 7:25 (KJV)**

<sup>25</sup> The graven images of their gods shall ye burn with fire: thou shalt not desire the silver or gold that is on them, nor take it unto thee, lest thou be snared therein: for it is an abomination to the LORD thy God.

### **Deuteronomy 31:20 (NKJV)**

<sup>20</sup> When I have brought them to the land flowing with milk and honey, of which I swore to their fathers, and they have eaten and filled themselves and grown fat, then they will turn to other gods and serve them; and they will provoke Me and break My covenant.

### **Psalms 62:10 (NIV)**

<sup>10</sup> Do not trust in extortion or take pride in stolen goods; though your riches increase, do not set your heart on them.

### **Deuteronomy 8:18 (KJV)**

<sup>18</sup> But thou shalt remember the LORD thy God: for it is he that giveth thee power to get wealth, that he may establish his covenant which he swore unto thy fathers, as it is this day.

### **1 Samuel 2:7 (KJV)**

<sup>7</sup> The LORD maketh poor, and maketh rich: he bringeth low, and lifteth up,

## 2 Samuel 8:9-12 (KJV)

<sup>9</sup> When Toi king of Hamath heard that David has smitten all the host of Hadadezer, <sup>10</sup> the Toi sent Joram his son unto king David, to salute him, and to bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer, and smitten him: for Hadadezer had wars with Toi. And Joram brought with him vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and vessels of brass: <sup>11</sup> Which also king David did dedicate unto the LORD, with the silver and gold that he had dedicated of all nations which he subdued; <sup>12</sup> Of Syria, and of Moab, and of the children of Ammon, and of the Philistines, and of Amalek, and of the spoil of Hadadezer, son of Rehob, king of Zobah.

## 2 Chronicles 9:22 (KJV)

<sup>22</sup> And king Solomon passed all the kings of the earth in riches and wisdom.

## Psalms 52:7 (KJV)

<sup>7</sup> Lo, this is the man that made not God his strength; but trusted in the abundance of his riches, and strengthened himself in his wickedness.

## Psalms 119:14 (KJV)

<sup>14</sup> I have rejoiced in the way of Your testimonies, as much as in all riches.

## Proverbs 3:9-10 (CEV)

<sup>9</sup> Honor the LORD by giving him your money and the first part of all your crops. <sup>10</sup> Then you will have more grain and grapes than you will ever need.

## Proverbs 8:17-19 (KJV)

<sup>17</sup> I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me. <sup>18</sup> Riches and honour are with me; yea, durable riches and righteousness. <sup>19</sup> My fruit is better than gold, yea, than fine gold; and my revenue than choice silver.

## Proverbs 16:16 (KJV)

<sup>16</sup> How much better is it to get wisdom than gold! and to get understanding rather to be chosen than silver!

## Proverbs 10:2 (KJV)

<sup>2</sup> Treasures of wickedness profit nothing: but righteousness delivereth from death.

## Proverbs 13:7 (NIV)

<sup>7</sup> One man pretends to be rich, yet has nothing; another pretends to be poor, yet has great wealth.

## Proverbs 16:8 (KJV)

<sup>8</sup> Better is a little with righteousness than great revenues without right.

### Proverbs 22:7 (KJV)

<sup>7</sup> The rich ruleth over the poor, and the borrower is servant to the lender.

### Proverbs 22:16 (NKJV)

<sup>16</sup> He who oppresses the poor to increase his riches, and he who gives to the rich, will surely come to poverty.

### Proverbs 24:19-20 (KJV)

<sup>19</sup> Fret not thyself because of evil men, neither be thou envious at the wicked: <sup>20</sup> For there shall be no reward to the evil man; the candle of the wicked shall be put out.

### Ecclesiastes 2:4-11 (NKJV)

<sup>4</sup> I made my works great, I built myself houses, and planted myself vineyards. <sup>5</sup> I made myself gardens and orchards, and I planted all kinds of fruit trees in them. <sup>6</sup> I made myself water pools from which to water the growing trees of the grove. <sup>7</sup> I acquired male and female servants, and had servants born in my house. Yes, I had greater possessions of herds and flocks than all who were in Jerusalem before me. <sup>8</sup> I also gathered for myself silver and gold and the special treasures of kings and of the provinces. I acquired male and female singers, the delights of the sons of men, and musical instruments of all kinds. <sup>9</sup> So I became great and excelled more than all who were before me in Jerusalem. Also my wisdom remained with me. <sup>10</sup> Whatever my eyes desired I did not keep from them. I did not withhold my heart from any pleasure. For my heart rejoiced in all my labor; and this was my reward from all my labor. <sup>11</sup> Then I looked on all the works that my hands had done and on the labor in which I had toiled; and indeed all was vanity and grasping for the wind. There was no profit under the sun.

### Ecclesiastes 5:10 (NIV)

<sup>10</sup> Whoever loves money never has money enough; whoever loves wealth is never satisfied with his income. This too is meaningless.

### Ecclesiastes 5:19-20 (KJV)

<sup>19</sup> Every man also to who God hath given riches and wealth, and hath given him power to eat thereof, and to take his portion, and to rejoice in his labor; this is the gift of God. <sup>20</sup> For he shall not much remember the days of his life; because God answereth him in the joy of his heart.

### Jeremiah 17:1 (NKJV)

<sup>1</sup> "As a partridge that broods but does not hatch, so is he who gets riches, but not by right; it will leave him in the midst of his days, and at his end he will be a fool."

### Haggai 2:8 (KJV)

<sup>8</sup> The silver is mine, and the gold is mine, saith the LORD of hosts.

### **Matthew 6:19-21 (KJV)**

<sup>21</sup> Lay not up for yourselves treasures upon earth, where moth and rust doth corrupt, and where thieves break through and steal: <sup>20</sup> But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal: <sup>21</sup> For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.

### **1 Timothy 6:9-10 (KJV)**

<sup>9</sup> But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition. <sup>10</sup> For the love of money is the root of all evil: which while some coveted after, they have erred from the faith, and pierced themselves through with many sorrows.,

### **1 Timothy 6:17-19 (KJV)**

<sup>17</sup> Charge them that are rich in this world, that they be not highminded, nor trust in uncertain riches, but in the living God, who giveth us richly all things to enjoy; <sup>18</sup> That they do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to distribute, willing to communicate; <sup>19</sup> Laying up in store for themselves a good foundation against the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life.

### **Luke 6:20 (AMP)**

<sup>20</sup> And solemnly lifting up His eyes on His disciples, He said: Blessed (happy - with life-joy and satisfaction in God's favor and salvation, apart from your outward condition - and to be envied) are you poor and lowly and afflicted (destitute of wealth, influence, position, and honor), for the kingdom of God is yours!

### **Romans 15:26-27 (NIV)**

<sup>26</sup> For Macedonia and Achaia were pleased to make a contribution for the poor among the saints in Jerusalem. <sup>27</sup> They were pleased to do it, and indeed they owe it to them. For if the Gentiles have shared in the Jews' spiritual blessings, they owe it to the Jews to share with them their material blessings.

### **2 Corinthians 9:11 (NIV)**

<sup>11</sup> You will be made rich in every way to that you can be generous on every occasion, and through us your generosity will result in thanksgiving to God.

### **Philippians 4:19 (KJV)**

<sup>19</sup> But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

### **1 Peter 1:18-19 (NKJV)**

<sup>18</sup> knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your father, <sup>19</sup> but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

**Revelation 2:9 (KJV)**

<sup>9</sup> I know thy works, and tribulation, and poverty, (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews, and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan.
