Exodus 28:3 (KJV)

³ And thou shalt speak unto all that are wise hearted, who I have filled with the spirit of wisdom, that they may make Aaron's garments to consecrate him, that he may minister unto me in the priest's office.

Exodus 35:10 (AMP)

¹⁰ And let every able and wisehearted man among you come and make all that the Lord has commanded:

1 Samuel 18:14 (KJV)

¹⁴ And David behaved himself wisely in all his ways; and the LORD was with him.

1 Kings 3:9-15 (KJV)

⁹ Give therefore thy servant an understanding heart to judge thy people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this thy so great a people? ¹⁰ And the speech pleased the LORD, that Solomon had asked this thing. ¹¹ And God said unto him, Because thou hast asked this thing, and hast not asked for thyself long life; neither hast asked riches for thyself, nor hast asked the life of thine enemies; but hast asked for thyself understanding to discern judgment; ¹² Behold, I have done according to thy words: lo, I have given thee a wise and an understanding heart; so that there was none like thee before thee, neither after thee shall any arise like unto thee. ¹³ And I have also given thee that which thou hast not asked, both riches, and honour: so that there shall not be any among the kings like unto thee all thy days. ¹⁴ And if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as thy father David did walk, then I will lengthen thy days. ¹⁵ And Solomon awoke; and, behold, it was a dream. And he came to Jerusalem, and stood before the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and offered up burnt offerings, and offered peace offerings, and made a feast to all his servants.

1 Kings 4:29-34 (KJV)

²⁹ And God gave Solomon wisdom and understanding exceeding much, and largeness of heart, even as the sand that is on the sea shore. ³⁰ And Solomon's wisdom excelled the wisdom of all the children of the east country, and all the wisdom of Egypt. ³¹ For he was wiser than all men; than Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, and Chalcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol: and his fame was in all nations round about. ³² And he spake three thousand proverbs: and his songs were a thousand and five. ³³ And he spake of trees, from the cedar three that is in Lebanon even unto the hyssop that springeth out of the wall: he spake also of beasts, and of fowl, and of creeping things, and of fishes. ³⁴ And there came of all people to hear the wisdom of Solomon, from all kings of the earth, which ha heard of his wisdom.

2 Chronicles 9:23 (KJV)

²³ And all the kings of the earth sought the presence of Solomon, to hear his wisdom, that God had put in his heart.

Job 11:12 (NIV)

⁶ But a witless man can no more become wise than a wild donkey's colt can be born a man.

Job 32:4-9 (NKJV)

⁴ Now because they were years older than he, Elihu had waited to speak to Job. ⁵ When Elihu saw that there was no answer in the mouth of these three men, his wrath was aroused. ⁶ So Elihu, the son of Barachel the Buzite, answered and said: "I am young in years, and you are very old; therefore I was afraid, and dared not declare my opinion to you." ⁷ I said, "Age should speak, and multitude of years should teach wisdom." ⁸ But there is a spirit in man, and the breath of the Almighty gives him understanding. ⁹ Great men are not always wise, nor do the aged always understand justice.

Job 38:2 (KJV)

² Who is this that darkeneth counsel by words without knowledge?

Psalm 49:20 (NIV)

²⁰ A man who has riches without understanding is like the beasts that perish.

Psalm 105:22 (CEV)

²² Joseph was in command of the officials, and he taught the leaders how to use wisdom.

Psalm 111:10 (NIV)

¹⁰ The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom; all who follow his precepts have good understanding. To him belongs eternal praise.

Psalm 119:33-38 (KJV)

³³ Teach me, O LORD, the way of thy statutes; and I shall keep it unto the end. ³⁴ Give me understanding, and I shall keep thy law; yea, I shall observe it with my whole heart. ³⁵ Make me go in the path of thy commandments; for therein do I delight. ³⁶ Incline my heart unto thy testimonies, and not to covetousness. ³⁷ Turn away mine eyes from beholding vanity; and quicken thou me in thy way. ³⁸ Stablish thy word unto thy servant, who is devoted to thy fear.

Psalm 119:97-100 (KJV)

⁹⁷ O how love I thy law! it is my meditation all the day. ⁹⁸ Thou through thy commandments hast made me wiser than mine enemies: for they are ever with me. ⁹⁹ I have more understanding than all my teachers: for thy testimonies are my meditation. ¹⁰⁰ I understand more than the ancients, because I keep thy precepts.

Psalm 119:125 (CEV)

¹²⁵ I serve you, so let me understand your teachings.

Proverbs 7:4 (NKJV)

⁴ Say to wisdom, "You are my sister," and call understanding your nearest kin,

Proverbs 8:32-36 (AMP)

³² Now therefore listen to me, O you sons; for blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) are those who keep my ways. ³³ Hear instruction and be wise, and do not refuse or neglect it. ³⁴ Blessed (happy, fortunate, to be envied) is the man who listens to me, watching daily at my gates, waiting at the posts of my doors. ³⁵ For whoever finds me [Wisdom] finds life and draws forth and obtains favor from the Lord. ³⁶ But he who misses me or sins against me wrongs and injures himself; all who hate me love and court death.

Proverbs 19:8 (AMP)

⁸ He who gains Wisdom loves his own life; he who keeps understanding shall prosper and find good.

Isaiah 55:9 (KJV)

⁹ For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts.

Ezekiel 28:3 (KJV)

³ Behold, thou art wiser than Daniel; there is no secret that they can hide from thee:

Matthew 10:16 (KJV)

¹⁶ Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

Matthew 12:42 (AMP)

⁴² The queen of the South will stand up at the judgment with this generation and condemn it; for she came from the ends of the earth to listen to the wisdom of Solomon, and behold, Someone more and greater than Solomon is here.

Luke 10:21 (KJV)

²¹ In that hour Jesus rejoiced in spirit, and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, that thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes: even so, Father; for so it seemed good in thy sight.

Luke 11:49 (NKJV)

⁴⁹ Therefore the wisdom of God also said, 'I will send them prophets and apostles, and some of them they will kill and persecute.'

Luke 12:11-12 (KJV)

¹¹ And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and unto magistrates, and powers, take ye no thought how or what thing ye shall answer, or what ye shall say: ¹² For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what ye ought to say.

John 7:15 (AMP)

¹⁵ The Jews were astonished. They said, How is it that this Man has learning [is so versed in the sacred Scriptures and in theology] when He has never studied?

1 Corinthians 2:16 (KJV)

¹⁶ For who hath known the mind of the Lord, that he may instruct him? but we have the mind of Christ.

Ephesians 3:18 (NIV)

¹⁸ may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ,

Philippians 1:9 (KJV)

⁹ And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment;

2 Timothy 2:7 (AMP)
